


Our Mission & Goals

The Grant Process

- Applications are accepted from local nonprofits
- Committees review & evaluate applications, and conduct site visits.
- Finalists are determined by Grant Committees
- Members vote at Annual Awards Meeting

Transforming lives

In many cases, the grants we give are “game-changers” for local nonprofits, helping them to increase reach or transform operations for the most good.

Interfaith Food Pantry & Resource Center

was able to set up a refrigerated Healthy Choice Mobile Food Pantry expanding their reach to at-risk families, children, and home-bound seniors in the area.



Table to Table – East Fresh Passaic

established multiple touchpoints in the most at-risk areas of the county to provide fresh, healthy food for struggling families.



Oasis – A Haven for Women & Children

created new literacy and math courses, and three new courses to help women to pass the high school equivalency exams.



Samaritan Inn, Inc.

Emergency Shelter Program was able to purchase another house to provide emergency shelter to the homeless of Sussex County and offer services to help them become self-sufficient.

Roots & Wings

expanded its services and Outreach Case Management program aiming to DOUBLE the number of young adults they serve who age out of New Jersey’s foster care system.
